

Adult Day Care Programs Most Frequently Cited Deficiencies January 1, 2020 – March 31, 2020

State wide

EDL checks – at least every 90 days
Communicable disease/health - staff
Plan of care within 5 days/review every 6 months
Medical assessment requirements
Services required – observe and document
Fire safety requirements
In-service requirements – at least quarterly
Heating system, room temperatures
Toilet room/handwashing sink requirements, water temperature
Drugs, hazardous product storage and use
