- Ensure the students are eligible to enroll in the Basic Course.

The Knowledge and Skills Test Overview

- Knowledge Test
 - > 75 questions with a 60 minute time limit
 - Students can take the Knowledge Test at an approved testing site or there is an option to test virtually (at home).
- Skills Test
 - A random pick of competency skills included in three different scenarios
 - Uses the RN Test Observer, actor and a proctor
 - Conducted at a regional or closed site

Scheduling the Knowledge and Skills Test


- Fees
