CNA RENEWAL

Tip: Please pay close attention to what documents are accepted and what is not, to avoid paying a second or third renewal fee!

WHAT DOCUMENTS SHOULD I SEND TO RENEW MY CNA CERTIFICATE?

Proof of 8 Hours Nursing Services for every two years your CNA certification has been inactive or expired.

Your renewal will be denied, if proof of Work or Private Duty does not meet the requirements.

In order to submit the correct documents after being denied, you will be required to pay the renewal fee again.

PROOF OF CNA WORK

Documents **ACCEPTED** for CNA Renewal

- Paystub
- W-2
- Letter from employer, signed and on letterhead

Staffing Agency - Work Schedule or Pay Summary is accepted!

EXAMPLES of a few documents NOT accepted for CNA Renewal

- Screenshots of your TMU screen
- Family Pictures
- Proof of Work from non-health care employers

Your renewal will be denied, if proof of work does not meet the requirements. In order to submit the correct documents after being denied, you will be required to pay the renewal fee again.

PRIVATE DUTY

Private Duty **ACCEPTED** Documents

• Letter from the caregiver stating your employment dates and duties you performed during that time.

EXAMPLES of duties **NOT** accepted for Private Duty

- Running Errands
- Cleaning House
