Statewide

EDL checks – at least every 90 days
Communicable disease/health – staff
Administrative records – staffing/volunteer
Program director/designee – required/qualified
Staff/volunteer orientation requirements
Plan of care within 5 days/review every 6 months
Services required – food service
No throw rugs, equipment/furnishings maintained
Fire drills
First aid and CPR training/supplies
In-service requirements – program policies
Administrative records – inspection reports
Safe, clean, sound construction, maintained
Written fire/emergency plan requirements
